A) Geographical Skills and Fieldwork	<p>1) ALL - I can research features of cities and villages. MOST – I can identify features of cities and villages on a map. SOME – I can explain some of the reasons for these features.</p> <p>2) ALL - I can use digital maps to identify different locations MOST - I can use digital maps to identify different locations and describe their geographical features. SOME – I can use digital maps to identify and compare geographical features.</p> <p>3) ALL - I can use digital technologies to accurately measure the distance between two locations.</p> <p>4) ALL - I can use symbols and keys on maps to build my knowledge of the UK and the wider world. C) Locational Knowledge	<p>1) ALL - I know the difference between the British Isles, Great Britain and UK. SOME – I can explain the difference between the British Isles, Great Britain and the UK using a map to help me.</p> <p>2) ALL - I can name up to six cities in the UK and locate them on a map.</p> <p>3) ALL - I can locate and name some of the main islands that surround the U.K.</p> <p>4) ALL - I can name several counties of Britain including those neighbouring where I live. MOST – I can explain the difference between a city and a county. SOME – I can explain the historical influence on some county names.</p>
D) Place Knowledge	<p>1) ALL - I am aware that different places may have both similar and different characteristics. MOST – I can describe the similar and different characteristics found in different places. SOME – I can explain why different places may have different characteristics, using evidence from maps to support my answer.</p> <p>1) ALL - I can explain how a locality has changed over time with reference to physical features. MOST – I can explain the reasons behind some of these changes, applying my historical knowledge to do this.</p>
