



Geography End of Year Expectations – Year 5 – All, Most and Some.	
1) Geographical Skills and Fieldwork	<p>1) ALL - I can communicate my findings using the appropriate vocabulary.</p> <p>2) ALL - I can use atlases and digital maps to locate countries and locations.</p> <p>3) ALL - I can use the 8 points of the compass and 4 and 6 figure grid references. MOST – I can use the 8 points of the compass and 4 and 6 figure grid references to describe the location of a place.</p> <p>4) ALL - I can use digital technologies to measure and record human and physical features in the local area. MOST – I can use digital technologies to help me to compare human and physical features between the local area and another locality.</p> <p>5) ALL - I can use digital technologies to locate features within 6 figure grid references.</p>
2) Human and Physical Geography	<p>1) ALL - I can explain how a location fits into its wider geographical location; reference to human and economical features. MOST – I can explain how a location may benefit from its human and economical features.</p> <p>2) ALL - I can recognise how physical and human characteristics can affect the lives and activities of people living there. MOST – I can explain whether the effect of physical and human characteristics on people’s lives will be positive or negative and why.</p>
3) Locational Knowledge	<p>1) ALL - I can name and locate many of the world’s most famous mountain regions on maps. MOST – I understand how mountains are formed, linking this to their locations.</p> <p>2) ALL - I can name the largest desert in the world. MOST – I know that there are hot and cold deserts. SOME – I can explain the difference between hot and cold desert, giving examples of each.</p> <p>3) ALL - I can use digital technologies to understand how land use has changed over time. MOST – I can compare maps to describe changes in land use. SOME – I can explain why land use may have changed over time.</p> <p>4) ALL - I can use digital technologies to locate the Equator and the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn. MOST – I can use digital technologies to locate countries along the Equator and Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn.</p> <p>5) ALL - I can identify key topographical features and land use patterns. MOST – I can explain how the topography and land use of a location can affect the population.</p>
4) Place Knowledge	<p>1) ALL - I can begin to recognise the climate for a given country according to its location on the map. MOST – I can explain a country’s location affects its climate.</p>
