


How to configure a Wii Device to Open DNS




Open DNS


Open DNS provides a cloud-delivered network security services, delivering automated protection against advanced attacks for any device, no matter where it is. Family shield is pre-configured to block adult content, you can set it up and forget about it.

How to Configure

- 1. Go to Wii U main menu.
- 2. Select System settings.
- 3. Select the internet icon.
- 4. Press the A button.
- 5. Click on Connect to internet.
- Press the X button or click connection in the top-right corner.
- 7. Click change settings.



- 8. Click the **right arrow**.
- 9. Select DNS.
- 10. Click Don't Auto-Obtain.
- 11. Enter Open DNS info. Don't forget the "." between each section.
- 12. Click on **confirm** to return to manual setting screen.
