- Plants need water, light from the sun and the right temperature to grow and become healthy.

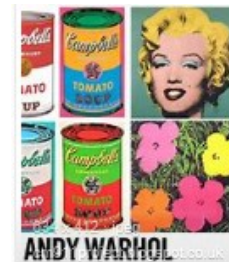

- Andy Warhol was a famous artist who lived in the 1960's and who created Pop Art., which is anything from drawing Coca-Cola cans to pop stars or the clothes people like to wear.
- He liked to use bright colours which he liked to switch around, and printing to create lots of copies of the same image.,
- Red, blue, and yellow are the primary colours. They can be mixed together to make purple,, orange and green (secondary colours).
- Mixing white paint to a colour, makes the colour lighter (tints) and mixing black paint to a colour makes it darker (tones).

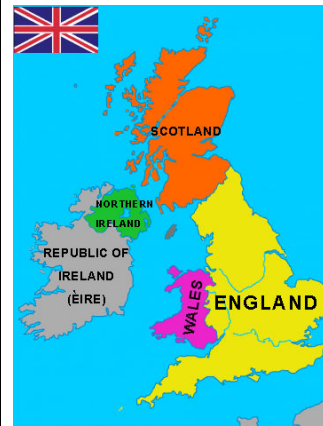
